




Fig.1-FORWARD CURRENT DERATING CURVE




Fig. 2- MAXIMUM NON-REPETITIVEPEAKFORWARD
SURGE CURRENT




Fig.3-TYPICAL REVERSE CHARACTERISTIC




Fig.4-TYPICAL INSTANTANEOUS FORWARD CHARACTERISTIC





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
