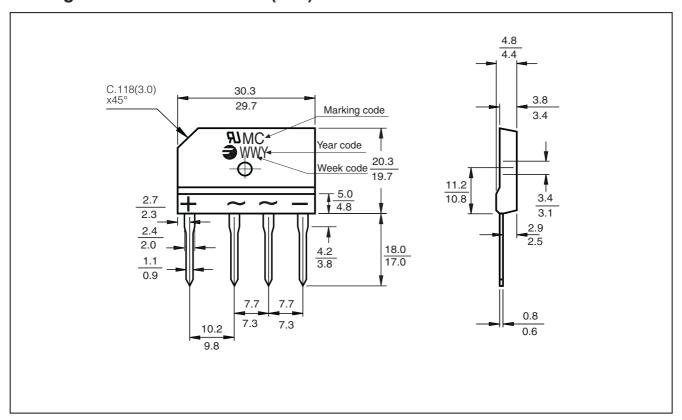

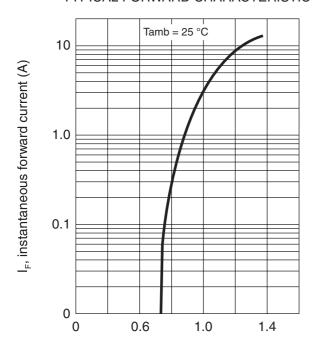

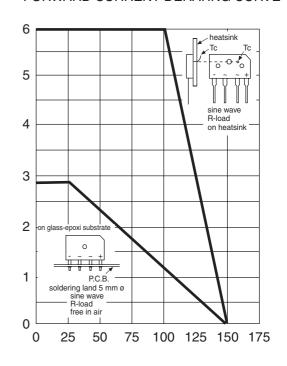

V<sub>F</sub>, instantaneous forward voltage (V)

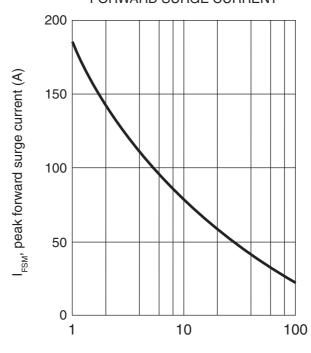
### FORWARD CURRENT DERATING CURVE
