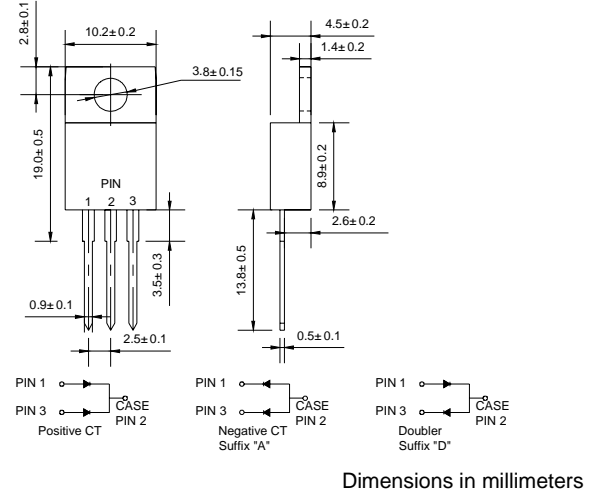

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FIG.1 – FORWARD CURRENT DERATING CURVE

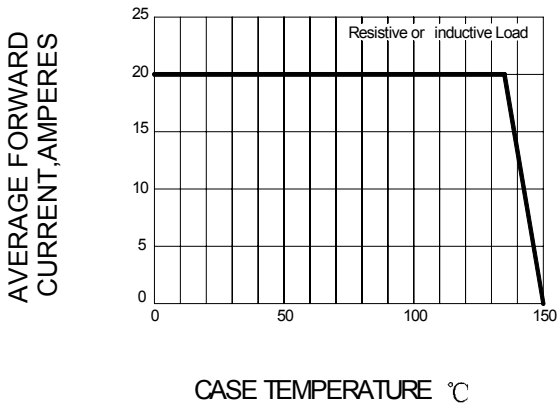


FIG.2 – MAXIMUM NON-REPETITIVE PEAK FORWARD SURGE CURRENT PER LEG

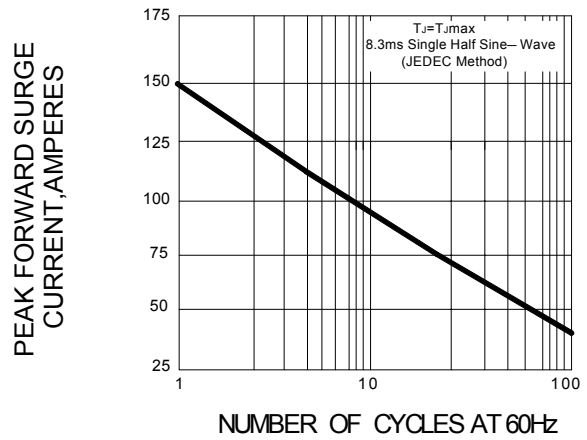


FIG.3 – TYPICAL INSTANTANEOUS FORWARD CHARACTERISTICS PER LEG

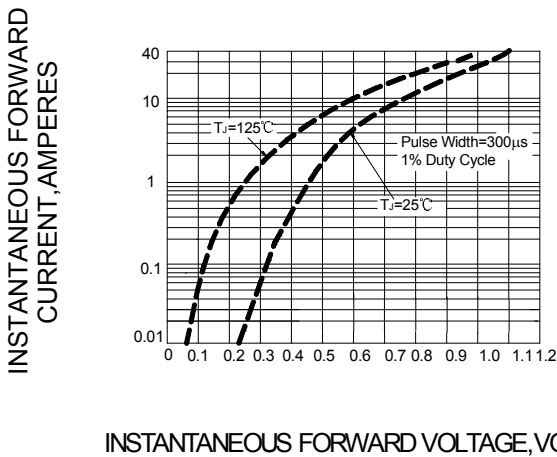


FIG.4 – TYPICAL REVERSE CHARACTERISTICS PER LEG

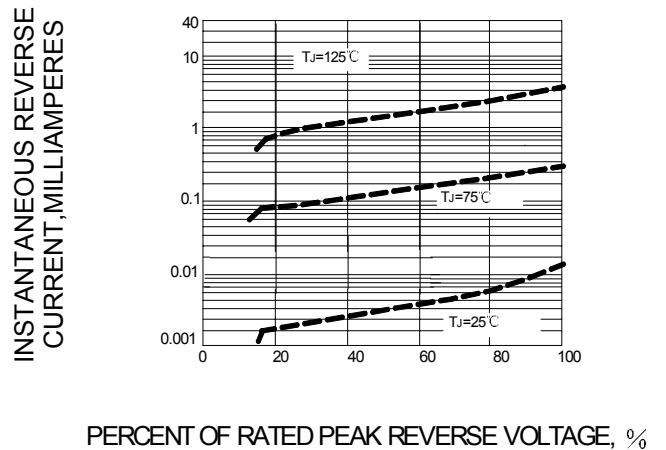


FIG.5-TYPICAL JUNCTION CAPACITANCE PER LEG
